4. When Hebrews 10:19 says "we can enter the Most Holy Place". with confidence and through the blood of Jesus, what did that mean? Why do we have confidence? How does the blood of Jesus open up a new and living way?
5. What does it mean that we can draw near to God? How do we take advantage of that new way to God we now have in Christ?
6. Pastor David talked about how the Tabernacle was seen as a holy space, the earthly dwelling of God; God's manifest presence was there in the Most Holy Place.

What do you think about holy spaces? Is this something that still exists or matters today? Think Biblically. How might scripture help you navigate answering this question?

7. Pastor David talked about how cherubim in the curtain that was torn (Exodus 26:31-33) and the cherubim guarding the entrance to Eden (Genesis 3:23-24) are a sign that God's plan is to call us home to dwell with Him in Eden, and that a big part of Heaven is when we come home to God as it was in the beginning.

If our original design and humans and ultimate end is to be with God in Heaven, forever, what does that tell us about how our lives are most fulfilled now?
